| Catholic Church & Martin Luther | Hierarchy breakdown - Recap of Feudal system and church hierarchy. Luther's 95 Theses & breakdown of Protestantism - differences between Protestant and Catholic Printing Press – and its importance |
| Reformation | Henry VIII & King's Great Matter – Reformation (creating a united monarch and church) to Protestantism – breakdown of Church of England Mary I – Changes and the counter reformation Elizabeth I – The Halfway (The Elizabethan Religious Settlement) |
| Stuarts | James I&VI – popularity issues - Religious issues Gunpowder plot - why it began and the consequences for religion and monarchy. |
| Civil War | Causes of the Civil War – Charles I's problems - issues with religion – exploring how does this lead to civil war? (Divine Right of Kings) Post-Civil War and Cromwell - no longer a monarch , the impact of the New Model Army and battles. Consequences – Regicide, Charles I's execution and its significance. |
