





Uniform – Guidance on shoes








All students are required to wear school uniform. Parents and carers are asked to support students to help them look smart and uphold the dress code.

Parents and carers should be aware that items labelled 'schoolwear' by shops may not be acceptable under Stoke Park's uniform policy. The following uniform guidance is intended to support in choosing school wear. The images below provide examples of the types of items that are acceptable.

Shoes	Plain black polish-able leather or leather-look shoes. No suede footwear. No trainers. No logos, flashes or coloured soles. Lace ups must have black laces. Boots are not allowed.
